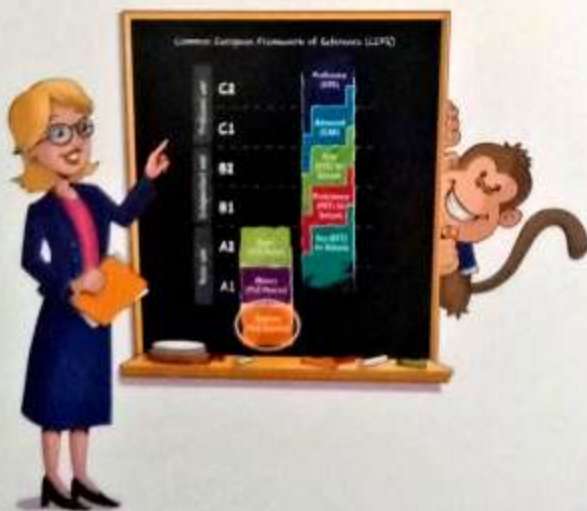

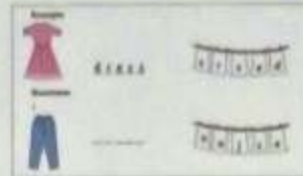

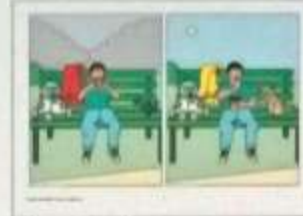

**Titbits:** Though there are many opportunities we shall make for students to practise their spoken communication, we always feel the need for a platform that would give our students the chance of displaying their writing skills. Titbits comes as a solution. Titbits is BCC's formal notice board that is inaugurated in each of the schools by the respective heads. 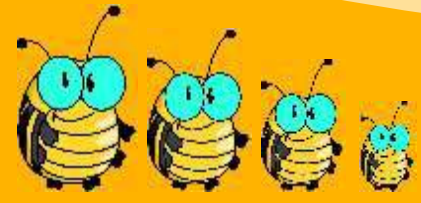
